

On **Wednesday**, **March 16 at 7:00PM**, PUMC is honored to welcome Deaconess Whitney R. Simpson as she leads us in an evening of a seated stretching, breathwork, and a meditation session, allowing us to become more embodied listeners. Whitney will share some of her own powerful story of surviving a stroke at age 31 and her journey of exploring ancient practices to re-connect her body and spirit. Whitney is an author of two books, co-owns the Bloom Yoga Studio in Lebanon, TN, and is the founder and director of Exploring Peace Ministries. She also is the creator of the *Exploring Peace* podcast. She will be joining us from Nashville, TN via Zoom.

# COVID-19 Safety Guidelines Update

As an act of Christian stewardship, PUMC considers the good health and well-being of not only our members, but also our community. We continue to seek to avoid harm and do good as we attend to the practices that help us grow in the love of God, as the COVID-19 Pandemic continues toward an endemic status. As a result of guideline changes from the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, we have updated our COVID Safety Guidelines:

- For Sunday morning worship, masks are optional.
- For Sunday morning Children and Youth Sunday School, masks are required for all in the Education hallways and classrooms.
- Masks are encouraged, but not required for all other meetings, gatherings, or groups. We recommend each group consult with each other on how to do good and avoid harm as a group in consideration of each other's needs and desires.
- We will continue to practice COVID-19 safety best practices throughout our building, including cleaning protocols and air circulation.

In accordance with the Wesleyan principle of do no harm, we strongly encourage our church community to continue practices that promote good health among our beloved community such as vaccinations, wearing of masks, frequent washing of hands, good air circulation, and social distancing. If community transmission spikes in our area, we may return to mask requirements for all activities.
